

WHAT TO BRING WITH ME

LUNA^o

Check-in

- Photographic ID – i.e. passport or driving licence.
- Student ID Number (University ID) – You will likely have received your student ID number within the offer letter from your university. This number is also typically displayed on university correspondence with you regarding your application and enrolment.
- A copy of your completed LUNA check-in documents – these will have been emailed to you by our property team a few weeks prior to your contract start. Don't worry if you are unable to locate these documents, just contact your LUNA property team ahead of arrival and they will resend the documents to you.
- Your rent account must be up to date to validate check-in, the quickest way to complete payment is via your online LUNA Students account. International payments and bank transfers can take up to 5-10 days to clear in our account, please allow ample time for any funds to clear prior to arriving to your LUNA property. We encourage you to reach out to your LUNA property team to check that your payment has cleared in our account before making your journey to the property for check-in.

ITEMS THAT AREN'T PERMITTED IN LUNA PROPERTIES

- Candles & incense
- E-Scooters
- Non-UK compliant electricals – all electricals must hold the Kite mark or UK CE mark
- Electrical appliances with a high wattage (above 200w)
- Rice cookers – are not suitable for use with UK power outlets and can cause fire risks.
